Information for older children

What is a child contact centre?

It is a safe, neutral and friendly place where children spend time with a parent or other family members with whom they do not live. Children may bring their own toys and games to play with and there are also activities provided by the Centre.

Who uses a child contact centre?

Centre users are families who are having difficulties arranging for children to see a parent or other family members with whom they do not live.

How does someone access a child contact centre?

By making a referral. Parents or solicitors, social workers, family courts or other professionals working with your family, can make a referral.
